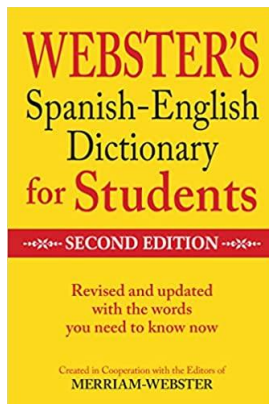


Families~
