THINGS YOU CAN DO AT HOME

*Talk about / use words in your home like "in", "on top", "behind", "up/down", "in front"...and demonstrate with objects around your home. i.e. "put your shoes ON the", "the cup is BEHIND the...", etc.

*Look for BIRDS in your yard or at the park. Talk about BIRD basics (i.e. "wings to fly, feathers to keep warm, beaks to peck/eat..etc)

*USE VISUALS (pictures of objects, places, actions) to emphasize what you are asking / expecting of your child. (Preschool staff can help with this if needed)

*Create a space for your child to have their backpack, etc. to go to school helping to create that routine and expectation of "going to school"

*Expect your child to follow 1 step instructions. (You can give gestures i.e. pointing, waving, etc.)

*Expect independence from your child i.e. expect them to follow you where you want to go without holding their hand in places you are comfortable allowing them to be.

*Expect your child to start taking care of their belongings i.e. put backpack in special spot, take things out for parent to see, throw away trash on their own, etc.

*Read short picture books to your child and talk about objects and actions in the story. Count objects, talk about the color and size of different characters.
