

How to earn the IB Diploma

DP Students must take **6** total IB assessments - one in each 'group'

- Group 1 = Language and Literature
- Group 2 = Language Acquisition
- Group 3 = Individuals and Societies
- Group 4 = Experimental Science
- Group 5 = Mathematics
- Group 6 = Arts or 2nd in other group

At least 3 of the assessments must be taken at the **HIGHER LEVEL** (2 years of the same subject) ~ a student CAN take 4 HL assessments.

A student *may* take one or two SL assessments in 11th grade.

Each assessment receives a score of 1 - 7
All assessments have both internally and externally assessed components



A student must earn at least 24 points * to be awarded the IB Diploma

- * Three HL assessments must total at least 12 points.
- * SL assessment - if student takes 2, must total 5+
- if student takes 3, must total 9+
- * No scores of '1' can be awarded
- * No more than 2 scores of '2' can be awarded
- * No more than three scores of '3' can be awarded

REQUIRED CORE COMPONENTS

All DP students must meet the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) learning outcomes as outlined by the CAS Manager.

All DP students must submit an Extended Essay and receive at least a score of D (A-E)

All DP students must complete two semesters of Theory of Knowledge course + submit a TOK essay for external assessment. A score of at least a D must be earned on TOK assessment components.

Students who earn at least a C in one or both of the EE and TOK components are awarded between 1-3 bonus points on the overall IB score.
