### Bear Down Days July 8 (virtual) and July 9 (in-person)

For those of you that are new to Basha High, Bear Down Days is an opportunity to purchase items from the bookstore and get some general information such as bell schedules, CUSD calendar, etc. We have a web page dedicated to Bear Down Days with all of the links and back-to-school information that you might need! That page will be live on July 8, 2024. You can make purchases for things like yearbooks and PE clothes and pay any class fees through the parent portal. If you would prefer to purchase items in-person rather than online, we will be available in the bookstore (F119) on July 9th from 7am-noon and 1-3pm (open house style). #### **Lunch Schedules**

Lunch Schedules SHOULD be available on your schedule this year! If not, the 24-25 lunch schedule will be posted on our website and around campus by July 15th. Your lunch time is determined by your 4th hour teacher (3<sup>rd</sup> hour teacher on odd block days). \*Lunch times printed on your schedule are likely, but subject to change \*

#### Parking Pass Applications

Basha High will have assigned parking spots again in 24-25. The number on your tag will be the spot you are to park in. Please find the parking pass application on our website beginning July 11th for SENIORS ONLY and July 12th for Juniors. Sophomores may not apply until Oct. 8. If an underclassman submits an application before July 12, it will be moved to the bottom of the stack to be processed. The fee is \$80 for the school year. Once your application is complete, please allow up to 2-3 business days for the information to be processed and the fee to be added to your parent portal. Your student will be able to pick up their pass in the bookstore on 7/15 or 7/16 between 7am-3pm or wait until the school year begins. More information is available on our website.

#### **Bell Schedule**

The bell schedule and school calendar will be posted on our website, under Bear Down Days Online. The first 3 days of school will be a traditional bell schedule (periods 1-6), and block days begin the next week. Wednesdays will be odd (periods 1, 3, 5) and Thursdays will be even (periods 2, 4, 6).

#### **Bookstore Purchases**

#### **Lunch Accounts**

CUSD uses www.myschoolbucks.com for student lunch accounts. You may also put money in your student's lunch account on Bear Down Day or send your student to school with cash or check to be deposited into their lunch account.
