To keep up with interests and reading requirements of higher learners, AP classes, and our 9-12 grade populations, we have included both juvenile, young adult and adult books at a variety of levels, including titles which may have mature content.

Whether a child is ready for a mature book is dependent on the maturity of the individual child and his/her ability to understand the themes, subject matter, and emotional content of the book. Prior permission from a parent or guardian is required for 7th-8th grade students to check out mature books. Indicate on the form below which of the three options you prefer: (1) You may choose to restrict access to all mature books. (2) You can elect to review each mature title; you will then receive an approval form for the specific mature book your student wishes to read. (3) If you prefer for your child to decide which books to read independently, you can elect the third option.
