Circle Time

Generally teachers begin this group time with a specific topic for discussion.

Specific routines focused on during circle time are:

1. Daily Schedule (predictability and group plan)
2. Singing (rhythm, repetition, rhyme)
3. Introduce concepts, letters, and sounds
4. Demonstrate Projects
5. Story time



Centers and Clean Up

Theme and literacy based centers

Opportunity to work on art projects, themed or skill based projects, therapy, and IEP goals

Promotes making choices and encourages social interactions

All students participate in cleaning up

Promotes teamwork and shared responsibility

Encourages responsibility and respect for their surroundings

Responsibility builds self confidence
