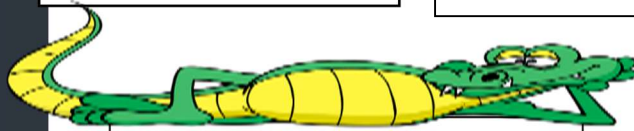
\*Please make sure your student brings their math book, homework, homework folder, and spelling notebook each day to class. This helps them be more successful each day. 😊

### Week of August 28<sup>th</sup>

**Essential Question:** How does exploring help us understand the world around us?

**Anchor Text:** The Puddle Puzzle

**Target Skill:** Setting, Elements of a Drama

**Target Strategy:** Ask and Answer Questions

**High Frequency Words:** baby, bird, blue, bring, fly, her, little, place, she, this

**Target Vocabulary:** Examine, Identify, Record, ace, agency, business, confidently, eagerly, located, mossy, mystery, outstretched, pavement, scoop, seeps, underside

**Grammar:** Words that name places

**Phonics Review:** Blends with L, R, S

**Vocabulary Strategies:** inflections -S, -ES, plural nouns

**Speaking/Listening:** Collaborative Conversations

**Writing:** Learn and write Compound Sentences/ continue simple sentences with details and prepositions
