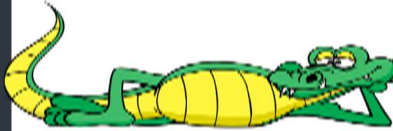

**Essential Question:** How does weather affect us?

**Anchor Text:** Wild Weather

**Target Skill:** Point of View; text features

**Target Strategy:** Making inferences; text organization

**High Frequency Words:** any, cried, didn't, funny, hello, laugh, pretty, slowly, song, were

**Target Vocabulary:** climate, precipitation, temperature, accurate, boast, chief, hazy, ruin, toasty, clings, damage, excess, funnel, occur, pellets, predict, tough

**Grammar:** Pronouns
