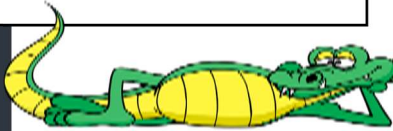

**Target Skill:** Central Topic and Details; text features

**Target Strategy:** Summarize

**High Frequency Words:** water, frozen, tiny, winter, doesn't, standing, warm

**Target Vocabulary:** waterproof, steer, whistle, slippery, otherwise, finally, junior, webbed

**Grammar:** Parts of speech- adjectives

**Phonics Review:** Sounds of "er" with "er", "ir", "ur", "ear"
