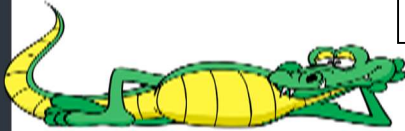

Essential Question: What lessons can we learn from characters in stories?

Anchor Text: If the Shoe Fits: Two Cinderella Stories

Target Skill: Story Structure/ Main Idea and Details; Cause and Effect

Target Strategy: Making Connections

High Frequency Words: clean, feel, ground, horse, leave, need, please, queen, seen, tree

Target Vocabulary: Moral, Relate, Version, console, contained, escaping, gently, indigestion, literary, beamed, chore, dashed, hobbled, jealous, pleasure, superb, thrilled
