\*Please make sure your student brings their math book, homework, homework folder, and spelling notebook each day to class. This helps them be more successful each day. 😊

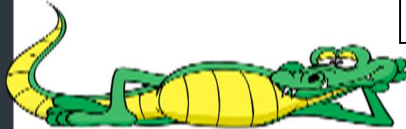
