Weekly Fact Tests

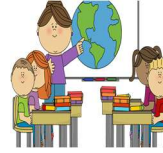
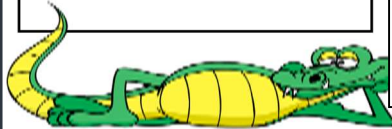
