- •Birthday celebrations will be held the last 20 minutes of the school day in order to not interrupt learning.



•Each child needs to pay the \$25 field trip fee in Infinite Campus



- •You can also call the office with a last minute change and they'll notify me.




Secret Student and Dojo Points

- •Students <u>must</u> wear tennis shoes on P.E. days. *Please double tie them. Girls must also wear shorts or pants.


Homework Folder


•I meet with each reading group everyday. The books go home Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.


•The reading book needs to be read by your child and <u>returned the</u> <u>following day.</u> Another book cannot be sent home until the previous day's book is brought back.

•These books are directly related to our daily leveled/guided reading instruction.

•The reading folders are different from the purple Home and Back/homework folders.







Factors that contribute to grades in writing:

- •<u>Writing</u>- opinion pieces, informative/explanatory texts, narratives, writing process, research, conventions, handwriting (legibility and correct letter formations)
- •Language- <u>spelling</u> (will be graded second quarter), weekly focused rule/high frequency words
- <u>Vocabulary</u> based on weekly Into Reading's story and math concepts


Math Grades

Goals For Your Student

Social Skills:

- •Students should be able to state their first and last names. Teacher's name and room 10 as well.
- •Students should be able to ask the teacher/other students for things in a full sentence.
- •Students should be able to maintain a conversation for 2-3 turns.
- •Students should be able to ask and answer questions.
- •Students should be able to clean up mess they have made.
- •Students should be able to express to another student something they don't like.
- •Students should be able to follow the 5 class rules.
- •Students should accept responsibility for actions.
- Students should be able to tie shoes. Double knots are encouraged.





Students should be able to write their names and the dates neatly.

- •Students should be able to write sentences including capitals, spaces, and punctuation.
- ·Students should know how to count to 120 and have one to one
- correspondence.
- •Students should be able to complete addition and subtraction problems including story problems.
- ·Students should be reading at grade level by the end of the school year.
- Students should be able to comprehend the story and in written form explain details, characters, setting, and problem/solution of the story.
- Students should be able to justify answers given.
- ·Students should be able to write and read their sight words.
- ·Students should be able to create consonant/vowel/consonant words (CVC).
- •Students should be able to write small paragraphs (4-5 sentences) on topic.

- •Be consistent with homework and reading assignments.
- •Set a special place for your child to work and take time to check it.
- •Express interest in their work. If they see that you think it is important then they will too and try harder.
