Principal Remarks:

- PTO has funds raised from last year's Fun Run saved still ~\$40K. Will look to combine these funds with funds raised this year towards Shade Structure over basketball court. If additional funds are raised above what is needed the Shade Structure, other school improvement ideas will be looked at.
