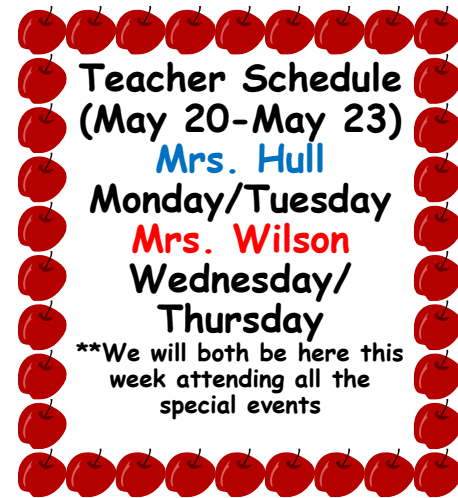

### In Spalding Language Arts we:

\*\*practiced oral phonograms 1-70

\*\*practiced reading for spelling and reading for reading in our spelling/vocab notebooks

\*\*practiced syllable types, pronunciation, spelling, markings, and rules of selected words.

\*\*practiced 4 different types of sentences with unfamiliar words

\*\*read regular and irregular past tense verbs and the "ed" ending to past tense verbs

\*\*explained that a phrase is a group of words and a preposition is placed before a noun or pronoun to show it relates to other words in the sentence

\*\*practiced Informative Paragraphs in the 3rd person

\*\*practiced 3 mental actions-1. Check for Understanding (Monitoring Comprehension)

2. Make Connections 3. Make a Prediction (predict type of text structure).

\*\*practiced a decodable book in the Spalding Readers Series-Informative

### In Math we:

\*\*we practiced 2-D shapes, composite shapes, fractions and will finish with 3 dimensional shapes for our last week.

### In Writing we:

\*\* students completed a circle map filled with ideas about a topic (Frogs). Then took the ideas from our class tree map including the conjunction "and" and the pronoun "They." They also incorporated adjectives.

Then created sentences:

Ex. Frogs can jump high and croak loudly.
