Execution:

- A. Coach’s Intent: Successfully compete in all phases of competition at DTDM
- B. Concept of the Operations
 - 1. Silver Talon, Tacit Blue and Vigilant Guard will perform rehearsed routines against opposing teams
 - 2. Members not assigned to a performing unit will provide support services

Administration/Logistics

- A. All team members will arrive at Hamilton High School NLT 0600hrs on 20241102
- B. All team members will arrive with appropriate personal equipment
 - 1. Team Members will arrive wearing the black drill practice shirt with AF PT sweat gear
 - 2. Carry the USAF JROTC Service Dress Uniform Coat set up according to their JROTC status; and their Short Sleeve Shirt in accordance with drill team uniform standards i.e., drill rank, ribbons, and cord.
 - 3. Cadets will wear corfams and flight caps with the service dress uniform
 - 4. Cadets will have appropriate under garments, DTAP and if necessary, medication (with proper paperwork)
- C. Upon arrival members will execute the bivouac plan
 - 1. Secure all necessary team equipment for performances from logistics area
 - 2. Move all team equipment to G105 and then to the bivouac area
 - 3. Conduct uniform and personal equipment checks
 - 4. Conduct personal appearance activities
 - 5. Team members depart to the bivouac area for the day
