CTA'S ACADEMIC PROGRAMS DIFFER FROM OTHER CUSD SCHOOLS IN THAT ...

We use the Spalding Method, a strong phonics-based spelling, writing and reading program, as the basis for instruction in language arts. This is supported by a district adopted research-based reading program and Accelerated Reader. Our math curriculum is accelerated using MyMath and Glencoe, one grade level ahead. CTA homework also meets or exceeds CUSD's homework requirements.

OUR ACADEMIC PROGRAM

The Chandler Traditional Program is designed to develop a solid foundation of fundamental and higher-level thinking skills through a structured and rigorous curriculum that is consistent within each grade level and sequential throughout the grades.

Kindergarten through sixth grade curriculum is taught using direct instruction, and research-based teaching strategies, while making learning relevant to each student. At CTA we strive to build relationships with our students and families that foster a love and dedication to learning.

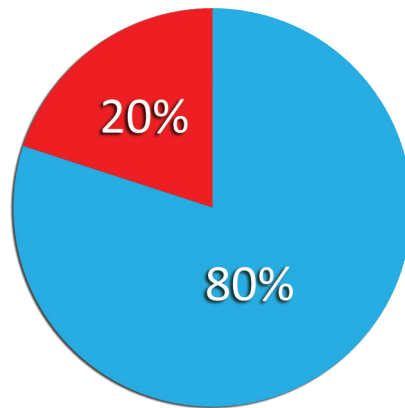
