To comply with Arizona State Law (A.R.S. § 15-872) Immunization requirements to enroll a school-age student into school, do one of the following actions before student can attend:

Enrollment WILL be delayed without the required adequate immunizations which are by Arizona State Law required for school/childcare attendance.

- Homeless students <u>have up to 5 school days</u> to show proof of immunization after immediate enrollment.
 Please contact the CUSD District Family in Transition Coordinators who can assist with questions about specific student needs.
 - Take your child's current immunization record and/or the "Referral Notice of Immunization Deficiency" to your healthcare provider or local health department to get the required immunization(s) and/or records. Bring proof of the immunization(s) back to school health office to be enrolled in school.
 - Register at www.MyIR.net or download the MyIR mobile app, verify your account and other family member's accounts for easy access to print official immunization records to bring to health office. You can also request a copy from your healthcare providers' office or visit AZDHS.gov for more information.
 - ☐ If you have any reason to waive required immunization(s), visit the AZHDS.gov website to obtain the required exemption form.

*Students 11 years or older will be required to have one dose of the Tdap vaccine if 5 years has passed since their last dose of tetanus/diphtheria containing vaccine. Students 11 years and older are required to have one dose of the Meningococcal vaccine.
