### **Course Description**

This course is the second year of a standards-based mathematics curriculum emphasizing real-life problems and applications. Students will examine rigid transformations, prove geometric theorems, similar and congruent figures, parallel and perpendicular lines with transversals, intro to trigonometry, and properties of circles. This course provides a more rigorous approach to the topics covered in Geometry as preparation for AP or IB programs. Students will use the standards for mathematical practice to engage with the subject matter.

Common finals will be in ELA, Math, Science, Social Science, and World Language.
