Warning Signs

- ★ Decline in school performance and behavior
- **★** Changes in school attendance
- ★ Talking, or joking, about suicide or making suicide threats
- ★ Loss of interest in things they used to enjoy
- ★ Unusual interest in death and dying
- **★** Taking unnecessary risks
- ★ Feelings of hopelessness
- ★ Depression

- ★ Bullying Both the target of bullying and the bully are at risk
- ★ Change in Friendships withdrawing from friends and social activities
- ★ Mood swings or personality changes
- ★ Increased use of alcohol or drugs
- ★ Giving away prized possessions
- ★ Changes in eating and sleeping habits
