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

Study Methods & Tips That Actually Work

Study Before Bed: When you're asleep, the brain organizes your memories. Instead of pulling an all-nighter, study a few

hours before bed and review the information in the morning.

Retrieval Practice: Remembering and writing down the answer to a flashcard is more effective than thinking you

know the answer and flipping the card over early.

Spaced Practice: Spacing out your studying allows your mind to make connections between ideas and build upon the

knowledge that can be easily recalled later.

Color-Coded Notes: Write down key points in red.

- Highlight important information in yellow.
- Organize topics by color.
- Don't color everything—just the key information.

Types of Colleges

- 2 Year colleges
 - Community College
 - Technical College
- 4 Year Colleges
 - Public
 - Private



2 Year Colleges

Technical:

- → Offer programs that emphasize hands on skills
- → Students often go right into careers in technical or industrial fields
- → Work with local employers to make sure students get the skills they need
- → Instructors are also often professionals in their field
- → Students can earn Certificates, Diplomas, Associates Degrees

Community:

- → Provide first 2 years of a 4-year degree
- → Students often transfer to a 4-year institution to complete a bachelor's degree
- → Also offer career specific training for professionals
- → Students can receive Certificates, Diplomas, Associates Degrees

































4-Year Colleges and

- Can be Public or Pruniversities
 - Public colleges are funded by local and state governments and usually offer lower tuition rates.
 - Privaté colleges rely mainly on tuition, fees and private sources of funding.
- Usually have on-campus housing
- Offer a wide range of majors
- Offer a wide range of athletic programs as well as programs in the arts such as music and theater
- Students must meet certain requirements to be accepted
- Degrees take 4 years to complete

Students can receive - Bachelor's Degree, Masters Degree

and Professional or Doctoral Degrees
