GOOD MANNERS and RESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR is not an option, it is an expectation.

Classroom procedures will be as follow:

**We will seldomly have Homework assignments, so PLEASE Do them on time and keep them in your sketchbook or turn in through GOOGLE CLASSROOM

**Make-up work is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY and is accepted only for <u>excused</u> absences. You will have one day to make up for one day missed.

**I will try to help you remember things via remind 101

**YOU MUST TURN IN PROJECTS in GOOGLE CLASS ROOM. I do not collect them. Accept and apply suggestions given and <u>don't take critiques personally</u> If caught cheating, you will receive a zero and a referral will be written.

**A participation grade will be issued each quarter. You will be awarded 2 points daily *No gum, eating and/or drinking* in class, with the exception of water!!

**Dress code policy will be strictly enforced (see student handbook).

**CLEAN UP PROCEDURES WILL BE PART OF PARTICIPATION POINTS (This includes cleaning up for the WHOLE class when it's your assigned day to clean.)

The Grading Policy in this class is as follows:

Grades are based on a point system. The total number of points earned will determine your percentage grade. Every day you don't work, you will lose 2 points, including but not limited to calling your name for not being on task, leaving the classroom too often etc...The grade for this class is quarter based 40% per quarter, with a **Final** exam worth **20%**.

LATE WORK: I WILL ACCEPT LATE PROJECTS (not class work, not sketch work) **only** <u>if</u> you stay after BEFORE school or AFTER school within 1 week of the due date</u>, with NO

POINTS taken off. This week grace period might be shorter if it reaches progress reports/report cards or final exams dates. IF PROJECT IS FULLY FINISHED BUT LATE, IF I ACCEPTED IT WILL BE WORTH ONLY 50%. You MUST TURN UNFINISHED PROJECT TO RECEIVE THE 50%.

****Extensions and exceptions will be made up to teacher's discretion.** (if you stayed after every day, or requested extensions virtually,but you are still not finished, and the project permits you **<u>might</u>** be allowed to work on it at home). Very rarely does this occur.

I will gladly speak with any student or parent/guardian concerning the students' progress at any time during the year.

NOTE: Grades will be available on-line CHECK FREQUENTLY I take pride in logging grades very promptly.

Grading art can be subjective, that is why **following directions**, turning projects on time, using time wisely and fulfilling requirements, specific to each project, will be a major part of the grade.

Art is an elective course, but by no means implies an easy "A". I hold VERY HIGH STANDARDS.

There is a \$25 fee for this class (per semester)

Accepting critiques and self evaluation is important in Art.

Stay dedicated, complete required work, be consistently present, demonstrate commitment and desire to learn, and remember that <u>GRADES are earned and not</u> <u>given</u>.
