Course Overview

Course Description

This course is the second year of a standards-based mathematics curriculum. Students will examine rigid transformations, prove geometric theorems, similar and congruent figures, parallel and perpendicular lines with transversals, intro to trigonometry, and properties of circles. Students will analyze the attributes and properties of two and three-dimensional shapes and develop mathematical arguments about their relationships. Students will learn to use logic, reasoning, and mathematical proofs to evaluate situations and select problem-solving strategies. Students will use the standards for mathematical practice to engage with the subject matter.

Assessments and Assignments

Students will complete assessments during each unit of study to assess their understanding. Students will complete the CUSD Common Final at the end of the first and second semesters. The Common Final will count for 20% of the student's final semester grade in grades 9-12 and 10% in grades 7-8 (some exceptions may apply at the Junior High level). Common finals will be in ELA, Math, Science, Social Science, and World Language.

Final exams will be given during the CUSD Jr High/High School Early Dismissal days in December and May, as identified on the [District Calendar](#).
