Usted/Ustedes Commands

You form **usted** commands with the **yo** form of verbs in the present tense. Drop the **-o** and add the following **endings**.

Infinitive	Present Tense	usted	ustedes
probar (ue)	yo pruebo	pruebe	prueben
comer	yo como	coma	coman
añadir	yo añado	añada	añadan

Pronoun Placement with Commands

In **affirmative commands**, you **attach object pronouns** to the end of the **verb**.

attached →

Affirmative: **Llévenos** al supermercado.
Take us to the supermarket.

In **negative commands**, you place **object pronouns** before the **verb** and after **no**.

before →

Negative: **No le venda** esta camisa.
Don't sell her this shirt.
