Grading Policy

Your child's classroom assignments will be graded as follows:

+ Meeting and exceeding standard(MS) - Excellent (80%+)

 $\sqrt{\text{Progressing}(P)-\text{Satisfactory}}$ (70%-79%)

- Area of Concern(AC)-Improvement needed (69% & below)

In the primary grades, I feel that the children can relate much better to the symbol (plus, check & minus) grading system. Occasionally, the students will also have a percentage grade on their work. (Most of the time, the assignments that have a percentage written on the paper are the grades that will be entered into Infinite Campus.) Please keep in mind that we all strive for excellent; however, a Satisfactory grade is completely alright, as we all have room to improve and grow. An 'Area of Concern' grade would be something to definitely work on and improve. Also, please remember, that your child's grades are confidential. Each child grows and learns at his/her own ability.
