Course Description

This course develops student understanding of proportional relationships, operations with rational numbers, and work with expressions, inequalities, and linear equations. Students will extend their previous knowledge of fractions, decimals, and integers, solve problems in a real-world context involving measurement, area, surface area, and volume, and investigate statistics and probability. Students will use the standards for mathematical practice to engage with the subject matter.
