2023 – 2024 Basha High School Senior Registration Worksheet

All registration is done via the Campus Portal of Infinite Campus. Students must log into the Campus Portal to register for courses. Students will use this worksheet to prepare for the online registration. Go to www.bashabears.com and select *A+ Grades Portal* from the under the images to access the Campus Portal.

- Students **must** select classes to fill six (6) periods. See below for “no class”.
- Students **must** provide at least two (2) alternate choice for electives. More can be entered online.
- Marching Band and Percussion are 7th period classes. They meet after school. Students signing up for these courses must complete the entire chart above and sign up for six (6) periods throughout the school day.
- Students who sign up for Off Campus Release Time (Seminary) must indicate by filling in one of their electives. This will replace one elective and yield no credit toward graduation. They will need a zero hour or COA class as it is mandatory to be enrolled in six (6) credit earning classes. Placement in zero hour classes is not guaranteed.
- **ZERO HOUR** - Students may select optional zero hour classes in addition to the required six (6). Possible zero hour classes are listed on the back of this form. They will only be offered if there is adequate enrollment and / or teaching personnel available. Zero hour classes are not guaranteed. You must provide your own transportation for zero hour classes.
- **NO CLASS** - Seniors who do not want a full schedule must sign up for the appropriate NO CLASS sections. For example, seniors who want half days sign up for NO CLASS 5 and NO CLASS 6 as electives. Seniors who sign up for NO CLASS sections may not have a gap in their schedule. All of their classes must be consecutive.
- **COA COURSE REQUESTS**-If you are requesting any COA courses you must request COA001-006 at Basha. These place holders must occur at the beginning and/or end of the school day.
