If I quit, I am dismissed from the team or when the season ends, my uniform is to be turned into Mrs. Mac in F115 with 2 business days. Uniforms must be hand washed and never dried in a dryer! If I need help caring for my uniform, I will see Mrs. Mac.

Uniform Care instructions: (Do and Do not)

1. Your uniform is not a costume. Please do not wear it for Halloween or let any baby sister, brother or cousin, friend, dog wear it.
2. We do not wear uniforms to school. We have spirit wear and T-shirts for school spirit. On pep assembly days, you will arrive in full uniform and change before attending the rest of your classes.
3. Please wash your uniform in the sink with Wool lite. Lay it out to dry on a flat surface where no dog, cat or toddler can get to it.
4. **Never, ever put the uniform in the dryer.** It will ruin it! Please allow at least 24 hours to dry your uniforms flat. Sometimes putting a fan on it will help.
5. Be careful when eating, applying makeup, painting or doing messy tasks while in uniform.
6. Stains can sometimes be treated with 3% hydrogen peroxide or oxy clean. Be sure to rinse the solution out. If it is a bad stain, see Mrs. Mac, she is very skilled at uniform care and stain removal. The trick is to treat it immediately. Please never use chlorine bleach.
7. Full uniform consists of: bow and hair fully back in a pony no wispy, fly away pieces. No chewing gum, food or drink is allowed on the track at games. Jewelry must be removed. If you weren't born with, you may not wear it. No nail polish, acrylics or nails past your fingertips. Failure to be in proper attire will result in your being benched until the issue is resolved.
