 Papa (David Logan) - Cassie's father, values independence, works on the railroad
Mama (Mary Logan) - Cassie's mother, a schoolteacher.
 Uncle <u>Hammer</u> - Papa's <u>brother</u>, lives in Chicago, short temper.
Big Ma (Caroline Logan) - Papa's mother, 60-years-old, runs the Logan farm.
· The Avery - trouble-making friend of Stacey, family Share crops younger brother named Claude.
• <u> Jeveny</u> Simms - often beaten for associating with the <u>Logan</u> children.
· <u>Lillian Jean</u> Simms - A prissy <u>seventh</u> grader.
Melvin and Rw Simms - brothers, make trouble, pretend to befriend T)
 L.T. <u>Movrison</u> - big, burly man, comes to <u>work</u> on the Logan farm.
 Mr. <u>Jamison</u> - local <u>lawyer</u>, very sympathetic.
• The Wallace Family (Kaleb, Dewberry, etc.) - family runs a general Store
violent, brutal people.
Harlan Granger - rich plantation owner, wants to buy back the Logan's land.
Point of View
 First person from Cassie's perspective. Uses <u>gossip</u> and <u>Story telling</u> to provide Cassie with information. Follows her <u>brother</u> around, makes <u>excuses</u>, and <u>refuses</u> to be left behind.
Racism / Discrimination
 It is not racism itself, but rather Cassie's realization of it that is important.
The Great Depression
 The parents talk about "hard times," the school <u>books</u> have been used for <u>cleven</u> years Save the <u>ShoeS</u> for Sunday wear, patches on their <u>clottes</u>. Transportation ranges from <u>horse</u> and <u>buggy</u> to beat up pick-up is nearly impossible to find.
