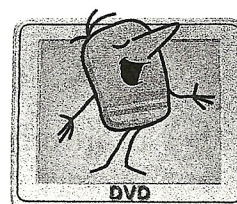

The verb *mettre*



The verb **porter** means *to wear* or *to carry*. The verb **mettre** means *to put something somewhere* or *to wear/to put on clothes, shoes, and accessories*. It is an irregular verb.

mettre			
je mets	nous mettons		
tu mets	vous mettez		
il/elle/on met	ils/elles mettent		

Je mets le livre dans le sac.
I put the book in the bag.

Je mets un pantalon pour la fête d'Eric.
I'm wearing pants for Eric's party.

Interrogative adjectives

- 1 **Quel** means *which* or *what*. It has four forms. All four forms are pronounced the same way.

	MASCULINE	FEMININE
SINGULAR	Quel chemisier?	Quelle jupe?
PLURAL	Quels chemisiers?	Quelles jupes?

- 2 You've been using **qu'est-ce que** to say *what*. It is used a little differently from **quel**.

Use a form of **quel** when *what* is followed directly by a noun:

Quelle cravate est-ce que tu vas acheter?

Use a form of **quel** when *what* is followed by the word **est** or **sont**.

Quelles sont tes cravates préférées?

Use **qu'est-ce que** to say *what* in most other cases.

Qu'est-ce que tu vas acheter?

- 3 A form of **quel** can also be used as an exclamation, as in *What a . . . !* In this case, the word "a" is not stated in French.

Quelle jolie robe! *What a pretty dress!*

Demonstrative adjectives

- 1 To say *this, that, these, or those*, use the demonstrative adjectives **ce**, **cet**, **cette**, and **ces**. The demonstrative adjective you use will depend on the number and the gender of the noun with which it goes.

	MASCULINE	FEMININE
SINGULAR	ce pull (starting with a consonant sound) cet imperméable (starting with a vowel sound)	cette chemise
PLURAL	ces pulls ces imperméables	ces chemises

Tu préfères **ce** manteau ou **cet** anorak?

Je vais acheter **ces** chaussures.

- 2 To distinguish **this** from **that** and **these** from **those**, add **ci** or **là** to the end of the noun.

J'aime bien **ces** bottes-**ci**, mais je n'aime pas **ces** bottes-**là**.
I like these boots, but I don't like those boots.
