Color or cross out each box as you complete the activity until you've done each square. Be sure to label each assignment with the corresponding letter and # (ex: N1) Do your best work!

<p>D1 Use graph paper to make a word-search puzzle that includes all of your spelling words.</p>	<p>D2 Create a cartoon strip using at least ten of your spelling words.</p>	<p>D3 Write a short story using all of your spelling words. <i>Make sure to underline each word.</i></p>	<p>D4 Write your spelling words in ABC order.</p>
<p>D5 Write all of your spelling words in a continuous line to form a picture of design.</p>	<p>D6 Use each spelling word in a sentence that shows its meaning. <i>Underline each of your spelling words.</i></p>	<p>D7 Draw a picture of your spelling words.</p>	<p>D8 Write a poem using at least 10 of your spelling words. <i>Underline each of your spelling words.</i></p>
<p>D9 Write 10 spelling words three times correctly.</p>	<p>D10 Create a game that can be used to practice your spelling words.</p>	<p>D11 Bubble Letters Write all of your spelling words in bubble letters. After you write your words in bubble letters, color your words with a crayon or colored pencil.</p>	<p>D12 <b>Backwards words</b> Write all of your spelling words forwards and then backwards. Example: <i>where erehw</i></p>
<p>D13 <b>Spelling Rainbows</b> Rainbow write all of your spelling words. Write each word first in pencil. Then trace over each word three times. Each time you trace, you must use a DIFFERENT color.</p>	<p>D14 <b>Hidden Words</b> Draw and color a picture. Hide your spelling words inside of your picture. If you have free time later, you can have a friend try to locate your words!</p>	<p>D15 <b>Spelling Shapes</b> Count your spelling words. If you have 30 words, draw 30 different shapes. Then write your spelling words inside of each of the shapes. Example : </p>	<p>D16 <b>Across and Down</b> 1. Choose all spelling words. 2. Write each word across and down, sharing the beginning letter.  Examples – <i>when      four</i> <i>h            o</i> <i>e            u</i> <i>n            r</i></p>
