Casteel High School Media Center serves our student population by providing a rich array of fiction, non-fiction, periodicals and suitable electronic media to meet most interests. To keep up with interests and reading requirements of higher learners and our older 9-12 grade populations, we have included both juvenile, young adult and adult books at a variety of levels, including titles which may have mature content.

Whether a child is ready for a mature book is dependent on the maturity of the individual child and his/her ability to understand the themes, subject matter, and emotional content of the genre. Prior permission from a parent or guardian is required for 7th-8th grade students to check out mature books. You may choose to restrict access to all mature books. You can elect to review each mature title before allowing them to check them out; you will then receive an approval form for the specific mature book your child wishes to read. If you prefer for your child to decide which books to read independently, you can elect the third option.
