Students must earn a minimum of a 2.0 unweighted GPA in each competency subject area.

Admission				
Requirements:	Arizona residents will be offered admission with an unweighted core GPA of 2.75 or higher in core classes with no deficiencies in the 14 required core classes. Students will be considered for admission if they have an unweighted core GPA of 2.5 or higher, and have no more than one deficiency in any two areas in the 14 core competency courses. If students have a combination of a math and lab science deficiency, they may not be admissible. ACT/SAT Scores are not required for admission, however, if a student chooses to submit official SAT/ACT scores, they may be used to help fulfill some core classes for admissions and scholarships.			
Honors				
College:	The essay prompts for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 admission will be available summer 2024. The application is set to open September 1, 2024 and the Priority Deadline is November 15 th , 2024 for Honors scholarship consideration for Fall 2025. To complete the online Honors application, you must first have been admitted to NAU and have your NAU ID and password. Also, please have your essays and resume ready to submit BEFORE clicking apply, in the required format(s). Their application is open on a rolling admission basis, but we strongly encourage students to apply and receive their admission decision to Honors prior to February 1 if a student is interested in living in the Honors Residential College. April 1 is our priority date to ensure enrollment in a first year Honors seminar. Admission to Honors will continue through the summer <i>on a space available basis</i> .
