Art Masterpiece Quick Facts

- You must complete and submit volunteer paperwork to the front office in order to volunteer in any classroom.
- Lessons are taught in the teacher's classroom.
- Arrive 10-15 minutes early to allow time to organize and/or transport supplies and art prints.
- Check in at the front office to obtain a visitor's pass and key to the Art Masterpiece supply room.
 - The key **must be returned** to the office at the end of your lesson.
- Preview the activity ahead of time so that you understand the directions and are able to support the students.
 - Bring any personal items or knowledge that applies to or enhances the lesson.
- Materials are organized by grade level in buckets. These buckets will have all supplies you need to complete the lesson.
- Encourage students to incorporate mistakes into their artwork. Discourage "do-overs."
- Prints for each lesson are next to the tall cabinet in the back of the room.
- Keep to the schedule; each lesson is allocated one hour.
- Ask the teacher for assistance/additional supplies as needed.
- Schedule three possible lesson dates/times with the teacher for each lesson. Email these options to the Frye Art Masterpiece Coordinator (fryeartmasterpiece@gmail.com), who will schedule your date/time. Planning ahead will allow for greater availability.
 - Only one class per grade level can complete a lesson at any given time.
