Meeting Animals' Needs

1. Choose an animal. Write its name above the chart. Begin with a population of 10 animals.
2. Roll the die five times in a row. Record each roll in the first row of the "Numbers Rolled" column. A 1 or 2 gives your animals food, 3 or 4 gives them water, and 5 or 6 gives them shelter. If your animals get all three, 1 offspring is born. If your animals do not get all three, 1 member of the population dies. After each round, record the number of animals in your population.
3. After 10 rounds, compare the sizes of the animal populations in each round.
