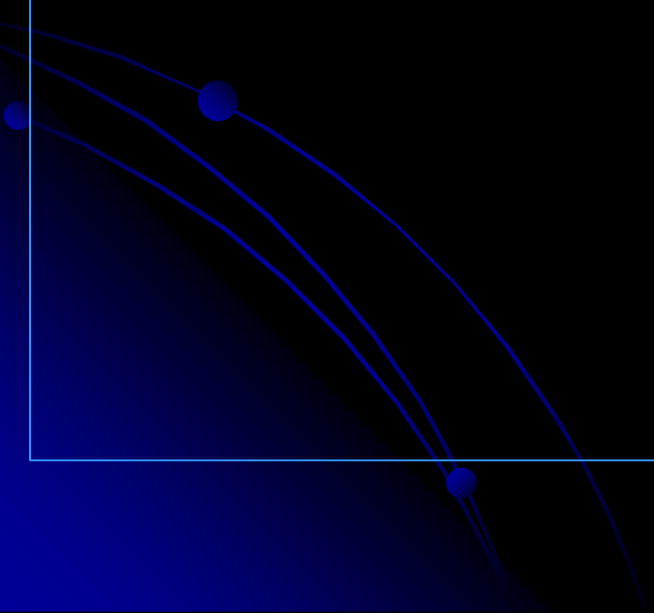
Let's share the Warm-Up
