Being Successful in 7th Grade

Here are some things that can help a student be successful in the coming year:

- <u>Stay organized.</u> Organization is an executive function that should be practiced on a regular basis. Organize backpacks weekly. Make sure that papers are in the proper place and that all assignments have been turned in. Take out items that are no longer needed.
- Ask for help. Learning how to talk to teachers is an important skill.
 Ask questions in class or send an email. Teachers may not know a student are struggling unless they say something.
- Attend tutoring. Each teacher holds a day of tutoring each week. If a student needs academic assistance, to retake or make-up an assignment, or to make-up work acquired from absences, please attend tutoring.
 - <u>Check "Infinite Campus".</u> Infinite Campus is a website that gives parents and students access to current grades. Check grades often!
- <u>Stay caught up!</u> It is important to be at school on time, every day, and to keep up with assigned work. The more assignments that are missed, the harder it is to earn good grades.

Your teachers are here to help, but your success is up to you!

Tutoring and Homework Hub

Students may attend a tutoring session for one of the following reasons: to receive academic assistance, to retake or to make-up an assessment, or to make-up work acquired from absences in content areas. Tutoring occurs Monday-Thursday, with each teacher meeting on a different day. Other times are available by appointment only.

If a student needs a place to do HOMEWORK, please go to Homework Hub which meets in the Media Center in the mornings before school (Monday-Thursday) or after school (Monday-Thursday). An after-school bus is available Monday-Thursday, unless specifically cancelled.

Students will need to know their addresses and major cross streets if they need to ride the bus.

The Agenda

Google Classroom

Each of the teachers on our team enters daily assignments in Goggle Classroom. Google Classroom is updated daily and includes information about each day's activities as well as access to worksheets and notes pages that can be downloaded and printed by students. This service is being provided so that a student who is absent for any reason can easily access class resources.

Use of Technology Information

Cell phones, smart watches, and other types of electronic devices must be turned off and in the student's backpack at all times during the school day unless given direct permission by a teacher. Using technology during class without permission may result in that technology being sent to the office. Technology that is sent to the office will need to be picked up by an adult by the end of the school day.
