Why take a CTE class at Hamilton? You will learn new fields and explore different careers while having fun, preparing for life, problem solving, and gaining skills you can use in the workforce. All CTE classes count towards graduation requirements.



Computer Science// AP Computer Science Principles is an introductory college-level computing course that introduces students to the breadth of the field of computer science. The course covers a broad range of foundational topics such as programming, algorithms, the Internet, digital information, big data, digital privacy and security, and societal impacts of computing. Students learn to create real working apps that they can share with anybody. They design and develop computer programs that might solve a problem, enable innovation, explore personal interests, or express creativity. They explore how the Internet works; the basics of how and why modern encryption works, and the basics of how computing is changing our world. The course assumes no prior computer science experience, but students must have taken Algebra 1.

Culinary// Explore the wonders of cooking! This class is an introduction to the culinary arts industry. Students will learn sensitization, basic cooking principles and terminology, dining room skills, organization, time management, as well as cooking in exciting labs. Students will be introduced to all levels of the Hospitality industry. Students will participate in events to support Culinary Arts 2 and 3.

Digital Photography// Photography allows you to create beautiful images while learning the ins and outs of the photography business. We focus on the artistic and technical photographic skills needed in the industry. Students have access to DSLR cameras, Mac computers and the Adobe Creative Suite, editing in Photoshop and Lightroom. If you enjoy field trips you'll have the opportunity to travel to different parts of our own city, state or country, even all the way to the other side of the globe. There are so many interesting things to photograph, including sports, landscapes, wildlife, architecture, people and more. Come join in the fun and take Photography at Hamilton!

Early Childhood// In year one of Early Childhood Education (ECE 100), students learn about the development of a child from conception to age eight. Topics include brain development, health & safety, nutrition, and guiding behavior. The RealCare Baby Project is also part of the ECE 100 course curriculum. Advanced ECE students learn lesson planning and have work-based learning experiences at an off-campus childcare center and the Hamilton Public Library.

Engineering// Engineering teaches students that real-world problems often have multiple solutions with many pathways to achieve success. With engaging courses like Introduction to Engineering Design, Principles of Engineering, and Aerospace Engineering, you can empower yourself to explore possibilities, experiment, learn from failure, and turn ideas into reality. Engineering encourages students to adopt a problem-solving mindset, engaging them in compelling, real-world challenges that help them become better collaborators and thinkers.

Graphic Design// Graphic Design can be described as an art class that is taught on the computer. The class starts very basic with learning how to use a MAC computer and file management. Students then complete tutorials in Adobe Photoshop and Adobe Illustrator to learn the software. Once students learn the applications projects are given for students to apply their knowledge. Graphic Design is highly recommended for any students interested in logo design, social media graphics, sports information media, creating posters, and flyers both from digital and print.

In Stagecraft, students design and build sets, props, and costumes for plays and musicals, in addition to programing and running all of the lights/sound and learning management and marketing. All students learn a little bit of each unit but get to choose which crew they work on for performances. We often partner for internships with Gammage and other local theatres.
