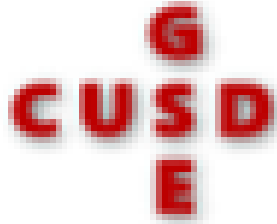
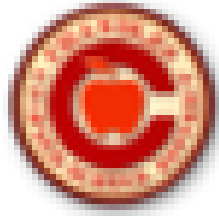

WHAT IS GOOGLE CLASSROOM (GS)?

Think of Google Classroom (GC) as your child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use Google Classroom to interactively teach lessons, post assignments, and other forms of communication with students and families.

Students use GC in interactively learn from their teachers, complete and turn in assignments, and communicate with their teachers.

GETTING STARTED IN GOOGLE CLASSROOM

1.

Click on the Google Chrome Browser



2.

Type in www.google.com in the browser.



3.

Click on Sign In in the upper right-hand corner.

Click on the Google Chrome Browser.

The ##### represents your child's 6-digit ID number.

If you are unaware of your child's ID number, you can find this in your Infinite Campus account.

DO NOT FORGET THE "s" in front of the numbers.

Your child's password during virtual learning is s#####!

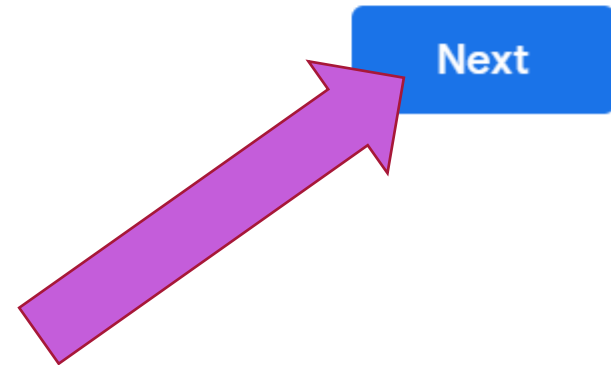
Again, s##### represents your child's ID number.

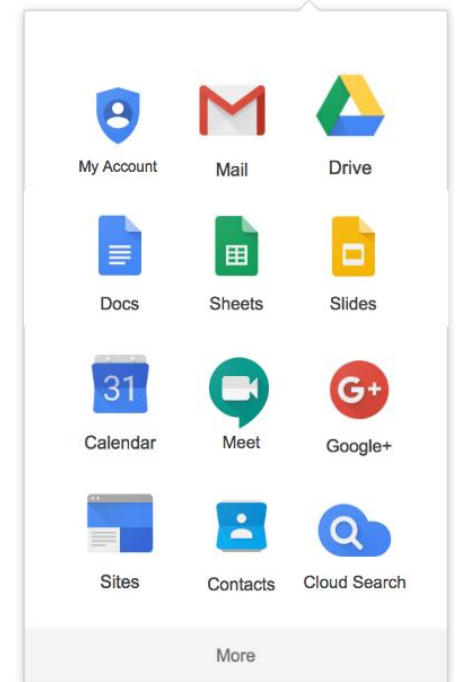
You will see one of the following icons in the upper right-hand corner of the screen. Click on the (waffle) grid on either option.

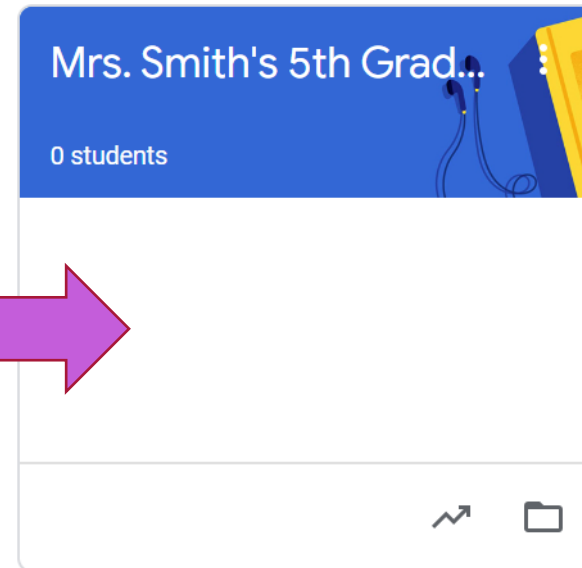

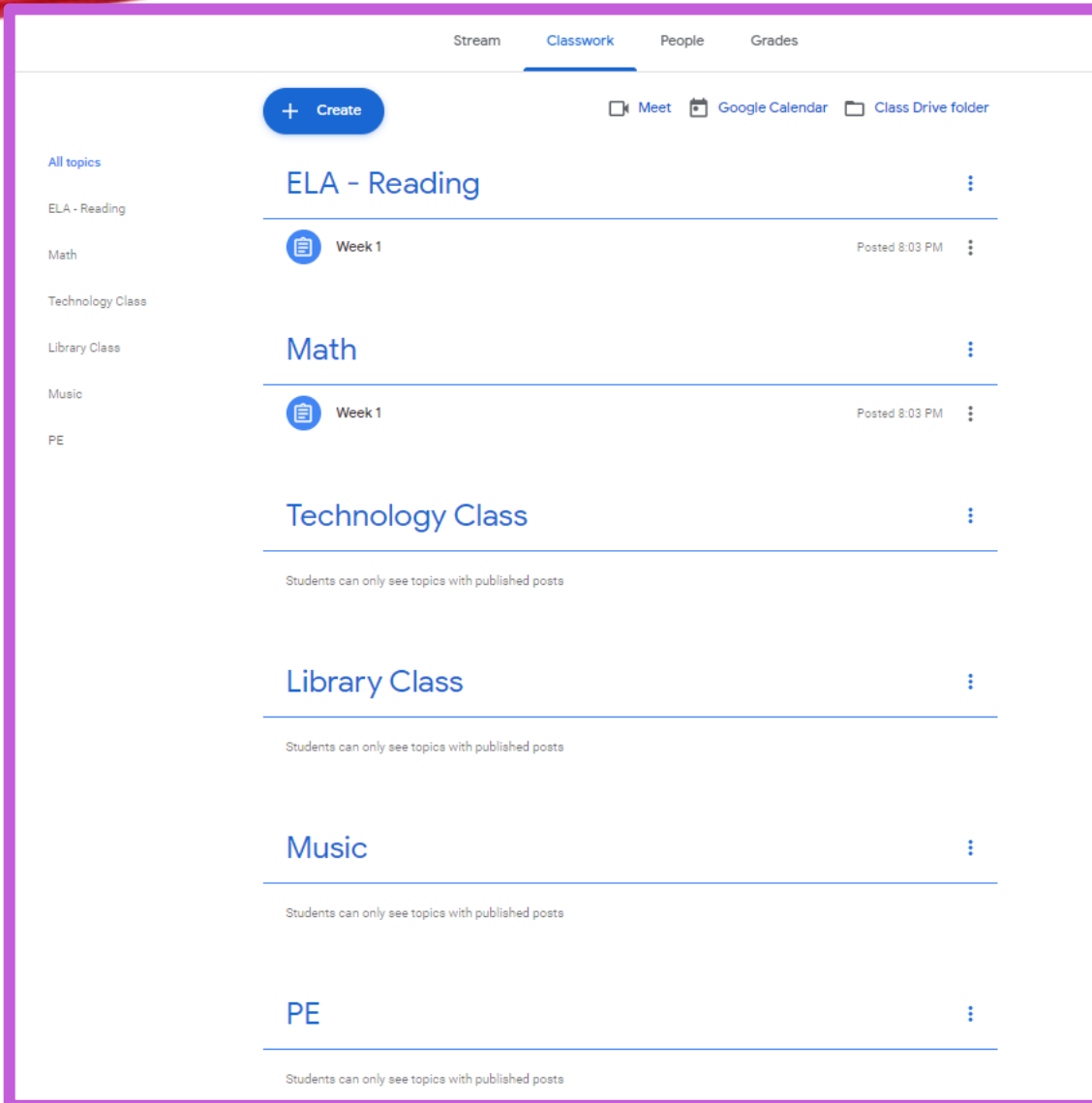

Stream – this is where your teacher may write you a note for the day or special reminders.

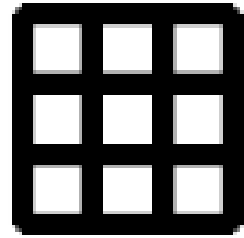

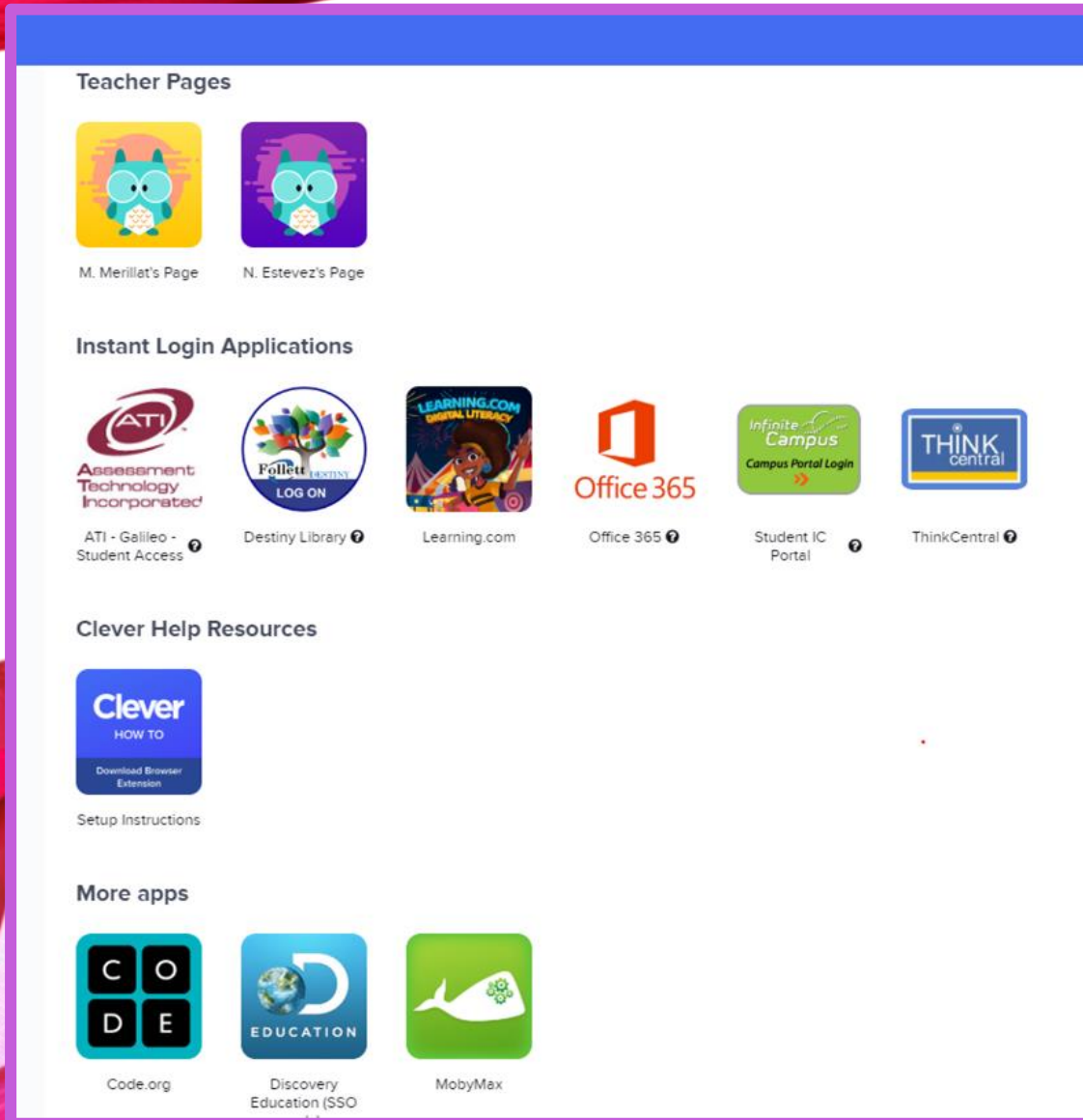

Clever is a service that makes it easier for schools to use many popular education technology products. It works by providing a simple developer interface (API) for third party education technology software to access important data from Student Information Systems (SIS) used by schools.

Think Central is the app that your Go Math and Harcourt Reading Program.

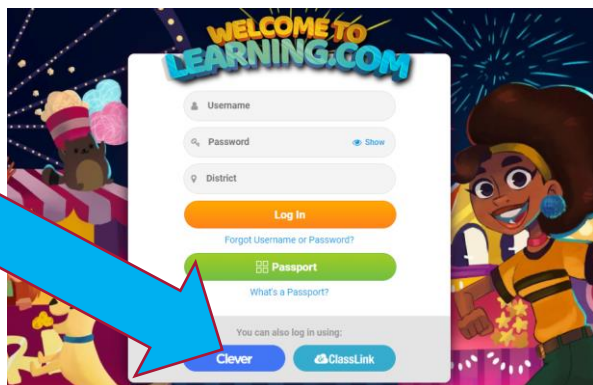
As long as you are logged into your Google account, when you click on any assignments assigned by your teachers in GS, it should take you right there.



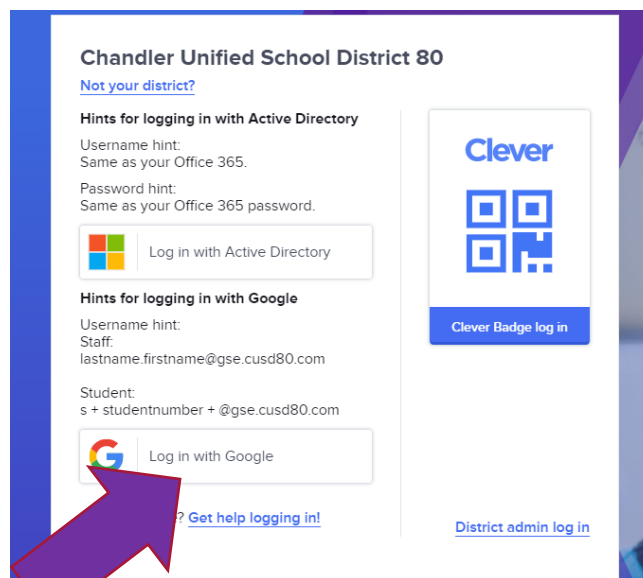
INSIDE THE CLEVER APP: LEARNING.COM

1. When you click on a learning.com assignment (most likely from your technology teacher. You may see the following screen.

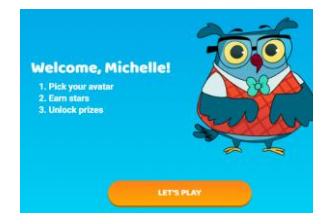
1. Click on Log in with Clever.



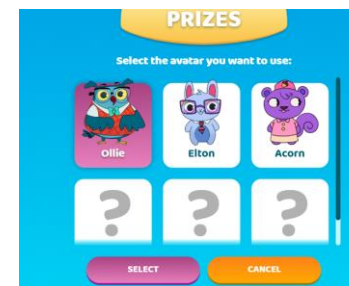
3. Click on Log in with Google.
