Weighting scale:

Quarterly: Assignments are worth 15% of total grade

Semester: Each quarter is worth 40% of the semester grade with the last 20% coming from the Semester Exam.

Late work:

Late work will be accepted up to the morning of the current unit test for partial credit. Beyond the morning of the unit test, all missing work will become a permanent zero on Infinite Campus.

Assignments are graded on completion. Any submitted assignments with no work shown, missing work, or work that does not appropriately match the content of the problem will be returned to amend and must be resubmitted. It will be counted as late work as it will have been deemed "incomplete" by the original due date and time and must abide by the late work policy.

Grades are updated several times per week. Please check Infinite Campus often to keep track of successes and needs for concern.

Tutoring:

I will have tutoring available during conference period as well as, tentatively, most Mondays and Thursdays after school. It is best if you let me know ahead of time that you are planning to attend so I can be sure to be in my room. Please know that this is NOT one on one tutoring and must be limited to the content we are currently working on.
