2024-2025 Tax Credit Expenditures

Principal Braaksma presented Tax Credit policies and procedures and provided a financial report detailing the actual general tax credit expenditures for July 1, 2023-June 30, 2024.

Principal Braaksma presented Tax Credit policies and procedures and gave an overview of the areas upon which Knox Gifted Academy has been or will be spending 2024-2025 Tax Credit monies, including: grade level field trips; transportation for field trips; Student Activity clubs (Running, Chorus, Student Council, Robotics, etc.); Co-Curricular areas including band, orchestra and choir; Character Education, Art Masterpiece, Jr. Achievement and Spelling/Geography Bee Programs; and fees for extracurricular activities.
