Geometry (1)

This class is primarily computer driven; however, there are worksheets, and a written test that are not on the computer.

- The computer is where you learn the material. It is your text book, homework and teacher. **YOUR JOB IS TO LEARN** so take notes and dig for understanding.
- Spiral notebook, leave the first 3 pages for formulas
- Computer mastery test may be taken 3 times to achieve an 80% (a 70% can be excepted if student desires).
- Computer Unit tests may only be taken once. Unit tests must be set by the teacher and taken at testing computers (no cell phones aloud on your person or nearby when taking a unit test). On a unit test a student may use a calculator and one 3 x 5 card.
- 3 x 5 card must be turned into the teacher after the test (please write your name and period on the card). The teacher will file it and give it back to you when you take the final. If you do not turn in your cards, then you cannot use them on your final.
- Written test will be taken at a desk and students may use a calculator and
- 3 x 5 card on the test.
- The Final (no cell phones) needs to be set by the teacher and students will be tested at testing computers. On the final, student may use a calculator and their 3 x 5 note cards that were turn in.
- Attendance grade will be a percentage based on the number of days the student is **in class and on time** out of the total number of days in the week.
- Notes: 50% cards, 10% label each sections, 20% content, 20% first 3 pages of notebook for formulas.

Grading breakdown:

- Attendance = 10% (put in grade portal weekly)
- Worksheets = 15%
- Unit Test 35% and written test
- Final = 20%
- Computer part = 20% (homework grade)
 - Notes/cards = 10%
 - Mastery test =10%
