ATTENDANCE

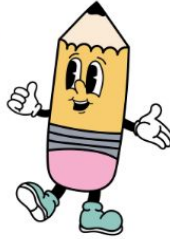
School starts at 8:05 am and the tardy bell rings at 8:10 am. Students are expected to be at school **Everyday** and **On-Time!**
