Arizona FCCLA Competitive Events Chart

General Guidelines:

- FCCLA Members must be registered with the State and National Office no later than February 1, 2018 in order to compete at both the State and National Level Traditional Membership must be submitted through the National FCCLA Office, Total Program Affiliation Membership must be submitted through the Arizona FCCLA State Office.
- A FCCLA Member may only compete in one STAR Event and one Arizona Proficiency Event at the State Leadership Conference he/she may not compete in two events in the same competitive events category (STAR or Arizona Proficiency).

STAR Events:

- All STAR Events will be offered at the 2018 State Leadership Conference, excluding the Online Events. (*Please note: Top two students/teams in each category receiving a minimum of 80% or higher will have the opportunity to advance to NLC; Only one team in Culinary Arts will advance to NLC*)
- All events listed are offered at National Leadership Conference (Students must qualify at SLC to compete at NLC).
- Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals are awarded to competitors at **State Leadership Conference** scoring a minimum of 50 points or higher (*Gold = 90-100 pts, Silver = 70-89.9 pts and Bronze = 50-69.9 pts*)
 - Gold medals ONLY will be awarded on stage at SLC. Silver and Bronze medals will be given in the exit packets at SLC.
- Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals are awarded to all competitors at National Leadership Conference (Gold = 90-100 pts, Silver = 70-89.9 pts, and Bronze = 69.9 and below)

Arizona Proficiency Events:

- Arizona-Only events with no advancement to NLC.
- 1st (Gold), 2nd (Silver) and 3rd (Bronze) are the only places that receive a medal in each Arizona Proficiency event at SLC.

Skills Demonstration Events – Ran by the National Office:

- Offered at National Cluster Meetings only with no advancement to NLC.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd places are awarded in each event at Cluster Meeting.

Knowledge Bowl – Ran by the National Office:

- Preliminary rounds are offered at each National Cluster Meeting in November; Finals are offered at the National Leadership Conference in July.
- Points-based scoring.
- Dependent on how many teams are entered at each Cluster Meeting will determine how many advance to National Leadership Conference in July.
