4.02 Citizen Comments

Former State Superintendent John Huppenthal, came to thank Bob Rice and Annette Auxier for their many years of service and recognize the cohesive operations of Chandler's school board. He has been tracking data for many years and Chandler is far above the national average.

Several students from Perry High School and other valley schools shared personal experiences of mental health and anxiety asking the Board to increase mental health funding and staff to work with students in CUSD.

Shannon Hayes, Adrianna Bryant and Felicia Gillespie commended the District for the work so far on equity and inclusion, but said there is still much to be done. A recent incident was cited where a student did not feel valued and safe. Parents send children to school to be in a safe and supportive environment. They specifically commended Dr. Sallu for her work and Dr. Casteel for her leadership.

7.03 Primary Math Curriculum

In an effort to increase readiness for primary grades in mathematics, the Exceptional Student Services department is requesting approval for TouchMath: The Alphabet of Mathematics. This curriculum will primarily be used with students requiring mathematical services on their individual education plan (IEP). TouchMath is a leading multisensory teaching and learning math program that uses a sequential strategy to improve math comprehension and mastery. The total cost across all sites for this purchase is anticipated to be \$112,612.00.

Dr. Casteel closed by wishing Mrs. Auxier and Mr. Rice the very best and announced that Arizona School Boards Association will honor both of them for their service at their annual conference Friday morning. This is the last board meeting of 2018. The District Office will be open during intersession, except on the holidays, but the schools will be closed. Laura Bruner and Lindsay Love, our two new board members, will be officially welcomed at the January 9, 2019 meeting.
