

Hancock Elementary PreKindergarten-Vallera Daily Schedule

8:00 a.m.-2:30 p.m.

<p>Arrival/Meet & Greet/Handwashing/Breakfast 8:00-8:30</p>	<p>Children and their families are greeted at door. Children put away their belongings, wash hands and have breakfast at a table with their peers. They will use the restroom as needed. Whenever possible, children serve themselves. Teachers talk with the children and ask open ended questions requiring thought.</p>
<p>Opening Circle 8:30-8:50</p>	<p>Children are led in a welcoming song or finger play. Other activities will include Foundations, presenting and developing the theme for the week/month, a math lesson, and discussing the day's activities.</p>
<p>Centers/Free Choice 8:50-9:50</p>	<p>Children participate in student led activities for building knowledge through play and interactions with teachers and peers. Teachers will observe and interact with individual children to extend play and learning.</p>
<p>Clean Up Time/Restroom 9:50-10:00</p>	<p>The children clean up all their activities. They will use the restroom as needed.</p>
<p>Outdoor Discovery 10:00-10:30</p>	<p>Children are supervised using the playground toys and materials. Teachers observe and interact with children as they jump rope, play ball games, blow bubbles, make nature discoveries, etc. The theme/lesson being studied may be extended outside, if appropriate.</p>
<p>Handwashing/Restroom/Literacy Time 10:30-10:50</p>	<p>As we come in from outdoors the children use the restroom as needed, wash their hands, and interact with a book/story independently, that incorporates the theme and learning of the day. Puzzles and listening center will also be available during this time.</p>
<p>Music and Movement Restroom/Handwashing/Prepare for lunch 10:50-11:00</p>	<p>Children will engage in music and songs that aid in gross and fine motor development. The songs will also tie into the days learning and theme. Students will then wash hands, use the restroom as needed and prepare for lunch.</p>

Lunch 11:00-11:30	Children are served lunch. Teachers talk with the children and ask open ended questions requiring thought. Children are encouraged to talk with each other.
Quiet Time 11:30-11:55	Children will have this time to listen to books/music on CD and rest on a mat.
Handwashing/Restroom 11:55-12:00	Students will use the restroom as needed, then wash hands and prepare to go outside.
Outdoor Discovery 12:00-12:30	Children are supervised using the playground toys and materials. Teachers observe and interact with children as they jump rope, play ball games, blow bubbles, make nature discoveries, etc. The theme/lesson being studied may be extended outside, if appropriate.
Handwashing/Restroom 12:30-12:35	As we come in from outdoors the children wash their hands and prepare for Circle Time.
Circle Time 12:35-12:50	Children are led in activities focused on extending the learning from the morning circle/center time, which may include books, activities in Science, Math and Language, but not limited to.
Centers 12:50-1:50	Children participate in student led activities for building knowledge through play and interactions with teachers and peers. Teachers will observe and interact with individual children to extend play and learning.
Clean Up/Closing Circle 1:50-2:00	Children will meet back at the carpet for reflection. Children will reflect on the day, what they learned, their favorite part of the day, and more.
Restroom/ Handwashing 2:00-2:10	The children clean up all their activities then wash their hands and prepare for snack.
Snack/Pack Up/Dismissal 2:10-2:30	Teachers sit with children and enjoy a snack together. Whenever possible, children serve themselves. Teachers talk with the children and ask open ended questions requiring thought. Children are encouraged to talk with each other. When finished they will take time to gather their belongings and pack their backpacks.
