#### 2 Year/Technical Colleges
























- Offer programs that emphasize hands on skills
- Students often go right into careers in technical or industrial fields
- Work with local employers to make sure students get the skills they need
- Instructors are also often professionals in their field
- Students can earn Certificates, Diplomas, Associates Degrees

#### **Community:**

- Provide first 2 years of a 4-year degree
- Students often transfer to a 4-year institution to complete a bachelor's degree
- Also offer career specific training for professionals
- Students can receive Certificates, Diplomas, Associates Degrees









### 4-Year Colleges and Universities

- Can be Public or Private
  - Public colleges are funded by local and state governments and usually offer lower tuition rates.
  - Private colleges rely mainly on tuition, fees and private sources of funding.
- Usually have on-campus housing
- Offer a wide range of majors
- Offer a wide range of athletic programs as well as programs in the arts such as music and theater
- Students must meet certain requirements to be accepted
- Degrees take 4 years to complete
- Students can receive Bachelor's Degree, Masters Degree and Professional or Doctoral Degrees









### Paying for your future:

Financial Aid – applying for federal financial aid (FAFSA) can help support students for paying for college. Counselors and Career Specialist will provide more information junior/senior year.

**Grants & Scholarships** – Some students may be eligible for a grant or scholarship or both to help pay for college or technical schools. Check with your Career Specialist junior/senior year for more information regarding scholarship search opportunities.






## LOOKING FOR THE RIGHT PLACE TO LAND?






# On the bar on left side, select ACADEMIC PLAN

- your 4 year plan is one piece of your graduation check out, so we update this plan every year in our ECAP lessons.






Choose an Academic Plan: Credit Check MYAP (graduation)

Choose Post Grad Plans: Two Year Private/Four Year Private/Four Year Public/Community College/Employment/Homemaker/Active Military Service/Other Postsecondary Education or Training/Unknown



Your four year "Credit Check MYAP Graduation" plan will appear. The courses you are currently and previously taken will appear.

For grades 10 - 12, select the drop-down menu for the courses you are planning to take.

• You only need to select courses for English, Math, Science and SS. If you are going to take a foreign language class, you can enter this in the elective field.

Make sure to enter both A and B semesters of your course work.
