# PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS & COURSES

## STEP 1: Review the promotion requirements.

**Note:** CUSD junior high students must earn a minimum of 4 credits each year in order to be promoted to the following grade level. Each semester passing grade earns 0.5 credits. Failure to pass both language arts and math will result in retention. Additionally, if students fail to pass one or more of the other core academic classes (science or social studies), they will either be retained or required to attend summer school. High school level courses taken prior to 9<sup>th</sup> grade do not meet high school graduation requirements.
