### Hand Washing and Elbow Sneezing

Please help me at home with these routines as they are a great help in containing and getting rid of the germs in Preschool. Here at preschool, we will be following a routine of washing our hands before school, after using the restroom, after outside play and before snack. We rinse first, get soap second, scrub for 20 seconds, and dry with a paper towel.

Also, we ask students to sneeze into their elbows as this contains the germs to a spot, we are not likely to touch with our hands. If we do touch it, we will wash our hands.
