What We Are Up To:

<u>4th Grade Reading</u>: Our reading selection will be "My Name is Maria Isabel." Our objectives will be to identify narrative elements and to make and confirm predictions.

<u>5th Grade Reading</u>: We will be reading a historical fiction story "Sees Behind Trees." We are focusing on Main Idea and Details and Creating Mental Images.

<u>4th Grade Math</u>: We are working on 1-digit x 1-digit multiplication and patterns with multiplying by 10s, 100s and 1000s.

 5^{th} Grade Math: The students will be learning the area method and the standard algorithm for multiplication.

<u>Science</u>: We will be studying vascular and nonvascular plants. Be sure to ask your child about the experiment we conducted this week!

<u>Social Studies</u>: We will be learning about the Spanish exploration and their settlement throughout the southwest.

Writing: We are finishing our "Me Bag" writing and then will begin a writing project called "Nothing Ever Happens at Hancock." Our focus will be on word choice.
